The U.S. Department of Education spends tens of billions of dollars a year on subsidies for higher education. The bulk of the spending goes to student aid, with the balance going to grants for educational institutions. Federal Pell grants are more than \$30 billion a year, federal student loans are about \$100 billion a year, and grants to colleges and universities are \$2.5 billion a year.¹
